## Uniquely St. Louis Stuff

One-of-a-kind is practically our middle name – from our hundreds of unique eateries and dining options to the “only in St. Louis” attractions like the **Anheuser-Busch Brewery**, **Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis**, **The Loop** neighborhood, **Gateway Arch** and **Grant’s Farm**. No one else can claim the delicious “concretes” at historic **Ted Drewes Frozen Custard** stand on historic Route 66, or replicate the quirky environment of the **City Museum** and its many attractions-within-an-attraction – there’s even an everyday circus!

### Citygarden

Citygarden is St. Louis’ newest free, world-class attraction and it’s a stunning addition to the region’s artistic landscape. The 2.9-acre park, which incorporates a unique design of water, stone, and architecture and 24 pieces of contemporary sculpture, features hardscape inspired by the area’s great rivers and three unique water features. There’s also the Terrace View, a glass-walled café, and a large video wall to screen video art and movies.

### Civil War History

The St. Louis area is steeped in Civil War history, and 2011 marks the sesquicentennial of the start of the War Between the States. Historic locales include: **Grant’s Farm**, home of General Ulysses S. Grant; the **Old Courthouse**, site of the Dred Scott slavery trials that led to the Supreme Court decision that helped ignite the Civil War; and **Jefferson Barracks**, a U.S. Army military post (1826-1946), where numerous generals for both armies served before the war.

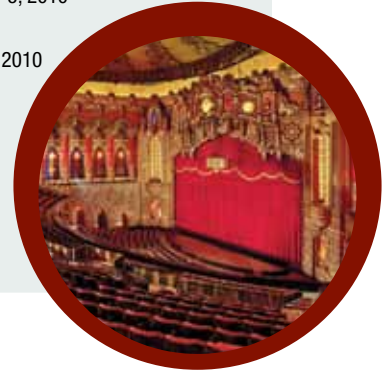
